Requests for Civil Protection orders are still being accepted for filing at the Clark County Superior Court Clerk's Office.


All Domestic Violence Protection Order (DVPO) dockets and non-DVPO dockets are moving forward by via video conference, telephone, or in person with strict observance of social distancing and other public health measures.

All petitions received in the Superior Court Clerk's Office by 11:00AM will be reviewed the same day by a judicial officer ex parte. Petitions received after 11:00AM will be reviewed ex parte by a judicial officer the next court business day. A review hearing of all temporary orders entered, or denied and set for full hearing, will be held by via video conference, telephone, or in person with strict observance of social distancing and other public health measures on a date set by the Superior Court.

Superior Court of Clark County

Granted orders will be available at the Clark County Clerk's Office after 3:30PM on the day they are reviewed by the judicial officer or make other arrangements with the Clerk's Office to obtain orders.
